FASTING TESTS

If you are having examinations of the Aorta/Iliac/Mesenteric, Pelvic or Ovarian/Testicular veins or Renal Arteries, you must not have anything to eat or drink from 9pm from the night before your appointment. Please avoid all fatty foods, dairy products and gassy drinks 24 hours prior to your test.

If you are having an ultrasound of your renal arteries you must also drink one litre of water over the 24 hours prior to your test and at least three glasses of water on the morning of your appointment.

Patients may take usual medication with a small amount of water on the morning of the examination. Please avoid chewing gum and smoking on the day of your examination.

If you are aware that you have excess gas in your abdomen a 20-30min walk prior to your examination can assist in minimising gas.

If you are a diabetic on insulin you are to have a light breakfast at 6am on the day of your appointment, consisting of 2 pieces of dry toast with jam or vegemite and black tea or coffee. You must then fast until after your test has been completed.
